

## **Community Service Groups**

**Closed toed shoes are required for Community Service. It is recommended that all participants wear their Congress t-shirt on Wednesday morning. See below for further descriptions of the dress.**

**Mill Creek Retirement Home for Horses:** Youth will be assisting with the bathing and grooming of the retired horses that reside at Mill Creek. Youth may also be assisting with basic farm clean – up if needed.

**Dress:** Youth should wear clothing they do not mind getting dirty. Youth should wear long pants as well as closed- toed shoes. Be sure that all clothing adheres to dress code. You will be outside so you may want to bring sunscreen and/or a hat.

**St. Francis House:** Youth will be assisting with preparing and serving a meal at a St. Francis house.

**Dress:** Youth should wear clothing they do not mind getting dirty. Please wear closed- toed shoes as you will be working in a kitchen environment. If youth have longer hair, please be sure they put it up in a pony tail. Be sure that all clothing adheres to dress code.

**Rooterville Pig Sanctuary:** You will be helping to clean out pig shelters and with basic barn up-keep and clean – up.

**Dress:** Please be sure to wear clothing that you do not mind getting dirty. Youth should wear long pants and closed- toed shoes. Youth will be outside so you many want to bring sunscreen and/or a hat. Be sure that all clothing adheres to dress code.

**Wilnot Gardens:** Youth will be helping within the garden with basic clean up, planting new trees, weeding, etc.

**Dress:** Youth should wear clothing they do not mind getting dirty. Youth should wear closed – toed shoes and they may also want to wear long pants. Youth will be outside so they may want to bring sunscreen and/or a hat. Be sure that all clothing adheres to dress code.

**Children’s Home Society Tot Spot:** You will be helping sort through donations to the thrift store. You will be preparing them for sale by hanging them up as well as pricing them.

**Dress:** Youth need to wear closed-toed shoes and make sure that all clothing adheres to dress code.

**Keep Alachua County Beautiful:** Youth will be cleaning and enhancing the community.

**Dress:** Youth need to wear closed-toed shoes, clothes that can get dirty and make sure that all clothing adheres to dress code. Youth may want to bring a hat and/or sunscreen.

**Gainesville Parks and Recreation:** Youth will be cleaning and enhancing the community.

**Dress:** Youth need to wear closed-toed shoes, clothes that can get dirty and make sure that all clothing adheres to dress code. Youth may want to bring a hat and/or sunscreen.

**Habitat for Humanity Thrift Store:** Youth will be helping sort through donations to the thrift store. You will be preparing them for sale by hanging them up as well as pricing them.

**Dudley Farm Historic State Park:** Youth will be helping in the crop fields with general weeding and field clean-up. Youth may also be grooming and bathing cracker cattle.

**Alachua Conservation Trust:** Youth will be cleaning and enhancing the community.

**Dress:** Youth need to wear closed-toed shoes, clothes that can get dirty and make sure that all clothing adheres to dress code. Youth may want to bring a hat and/or sunscreen.

**Ronald McDonald House:** Youth will be helping in the garden by raking, and picking up trash from outside the Ronald McDonald House.

**Dress:** Youth should wear clothing they do not mind getting dirty. Youth should wear closed-toed shoes. Youth may want to wear long pants. Be sure that all clothing adheres to dress code.

**Florida Museum of Natural History:** Youth will be helping weed the wildflower and butterfly garden, helping in the butterfly rainforest exhibit, working in the greenhouse, and trimming around the outside of the rainforest.

**Dress:** Youth should wear clothing they do not mind getting dirty. Youth should wear closed-toed shoes. Youth may want to wear long pants. Please bring gardening gloves. Be sure that all clothing adheres to dress code.

**Hose Work Community Service:** You will be making toys out of donated materials for a local organization.
